

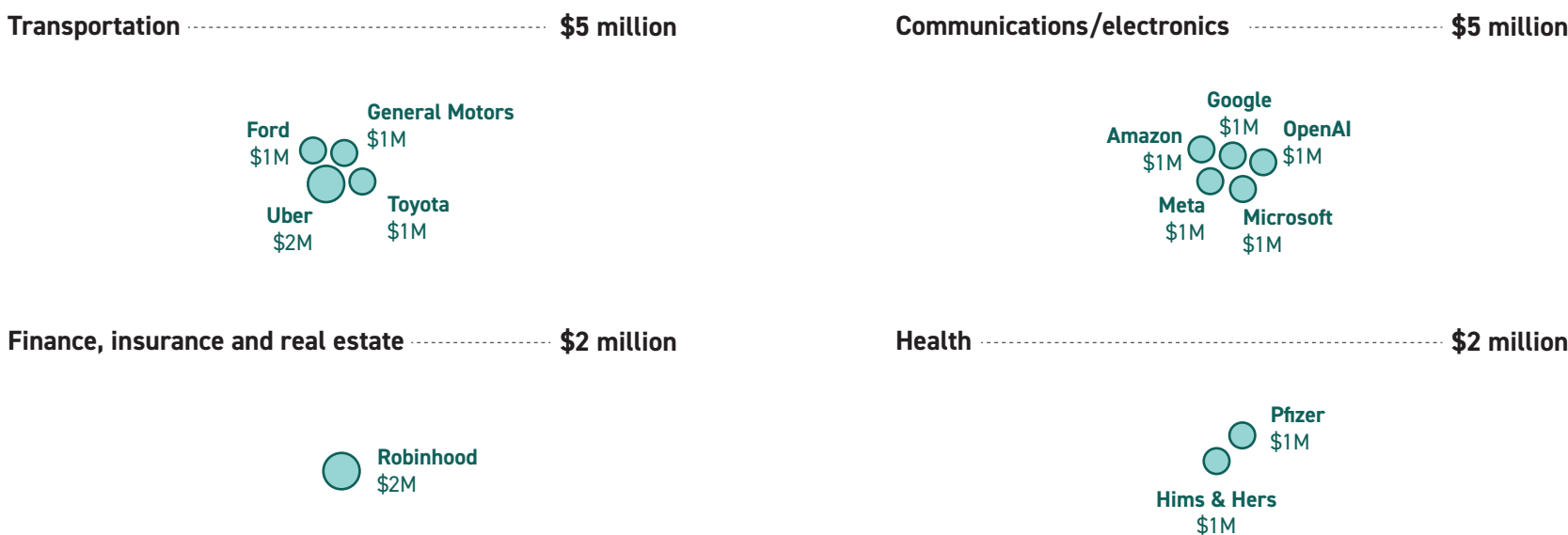
Industry giants confirm \$14 million in inauguration donations

Corporations across the transportation, tech, finance and health care sectors have disclosed donations to President Donald Trump's inaugural committee since his victory over former Vice President Kamala Harris last year, according to POLITICO reporting and other public statements. Trump's Presidential Inaugural Committee has not disclosed how much money it has taken in or from whom but at least \$14 million in contributions have come directly from a company or its chief executive. The sum is likely far greater.

This new wave of donations continues a trend seen in the 2024 election cycle when business donors across industries showed broad support for Republican candidates, according to a POLITICO analysis.

Industry groups poured \$148 million into backing Republicans who won in November

Industry-related groups from the finance sector spent almost \$105 million backing Republican candidates who would go on to win their races. Much of this funding was from crypto-allied committees such as Defend American Jobs, a Northern Virginia-based super PAC. Trump was among the top recipients backed among firms and leaders in the energy and natural resources sector.
